Day 6 Theme: Paul in Italy?

11.5, Sa Field trip: The National Archeological Museum in Naples, transfer to

Rome. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.

Overnight in Rome

Day 7 Theme: Renaissance and Baroque Rome

12.5, Su Field trip: walking tour of Rome, including Piazza della Republica, Church

of St. Mary of the Martyrs and the Angels, Piazza di Spagna (Spanish steps), Fontana di Trevi (Trevi Fountain), Piazza Rotunda, Piazza Navona, and Campo dei Fiori. Worship will be arranged when it is most appropriate in the itinerary. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.

Day 8 Theme: From Sect to Imperial Church

13.5, M Field trip: The Coliseum, Imperial Forum, the Palatine, view the Circus

Maximus, San Clemente Church (Mithraeum), Baths of Caracalla.

Dinner is included. Overnight in Rome

Day 9 Theme: Monumental Architecture in Imperial Rome

14.5, Tu Field trip: Catacombs of San Callisto, Monte Testaccio, Vatican museums

and Sistine chapel, Vatican City, St. Peter's Square, St. Peter's Basilica.

Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.

Day 10 15.5, W	Return to the USA or continue on the elective to Florence
Elective:	3 Days: Renaissance and Baroque Italy—Florence (\$1,353 based on a group of 10)
Day 10 15.5, Th	Theme: Renaissance Italy Field trip: depart Rome by train and arrive in Florence, walking tour including the central market. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Florence
Day 12 16.5, F	Theme: The Renaissance Field trip: the Uffizi Gallery, the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, Galleria del Accademia. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Florence
Day 13 17.5, Sa	Theme: The Renaissance Field trip: Free day for self directed exploration. Late afternoon train to Rome. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Rome
Day 14 18.5, Su	return flight to the USA
