Day 6 5.5, M	Theme: Optional Cruise Adventure or Free Day Field trip: excursions by boat from Sorrento to Capri or Positano (prices to be determined) Overnight in Sorrento
Day 7 6.5, Tu	Theme: Paul in Italy? Field trip: The National Archeological Museum in Naples, transfer to Rome. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel. Overnight in Rome
Day 8 7.5, W	Theme: Renaissance and Baroque Rome Field trip: walking tour of Rome, including Piazza della Republica, Church of St. Mary of the Martyrs and the Angels, Piazza di Spagna (Spanish steps), Fontana di Trevi (Trevi Fountain), Piazza Rotunda, Piazza Navona, and Campo dei Fiori. Overnight in Rome
Day 9 8.5, Th	Theme: Underground Rome Field trip: Ostia (ancient port of Rome), Basilica of San Clemente, (Mithraeum), Baths of Caracalla, Domus Aurea/house of Nero (time permitting). Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel. Overnight in Rome
Day 10 9.5, F	Theme: From Sect to Imperial Church Field trip: Catacombs of San Callisto, Vatican museums and Sistine chapel, Vatican City, St. Peter's Square, St. Peter's Basilica. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel. Overnight in Rome

Day 11 Theme: Monumental Architecture in Imperial Rome 10.5, Sa Field trip: The Coliseum, Imperial Forum, the Palatine, view the Circus Maximus, Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel. Dinner is included. Overnight in Rome Return to the USA or continue on the elective to Florence Day 12 11.5, Su 3 Days: Renaissance and Baroque Italy—Florence (\$1,411 (alumni); Elective: \$1,552 (1st time traveler) based on a group of 10) Day 12 Theme: Renaissance Italy Field trip: depart Rome by train and arrive in Florence, walking tour 11.5, Su including the central market Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Florence Theme: The Renaissance Day 13 12.5, M Field trip: the Uffizi Gallery, the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, Galleria del Accademia. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Florence Day 14 Theme: The Renaissance 13.5, Tu Field trip: Free day for self directed exploration. Late afternoon train to Rome. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in Rome Day 14 return flight to the USA 14.5, W
