Day 2 Theme: Introductions and Orientation
17.10, M Field trip: arrive Naples, visit historic Naples, touring as time permits, transfer to the hotel, orientation and introductions. Dinner is included. overnight in Naples

Day 3 Theme: Life & Death in the Shadow of Vesuvius
18.10, Tu Field trip: visit the excavations of Herculaneum, Oplontis, The National Archeological Museum in Naples

20.10, Th Theme: The Amalfi Coast & Classical Influences in Italy
Field trip: the Amalfi Coast drive, visit to Paestum. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.
Overnight in Sorrento
- Day 6
21.10, F Theme: Paul in Italy?
Field trip: Pozzuoli/Puteoli (Act 28:13-14), Flavian amphitheatre, forum, Phlegrean Fields, transfer to Rome. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.
Overnight in Rome
- Day 7
22.10, Sa Theme: Renaissance and Baroque Rome
Field trip: walking tour of Rome, including Piazza della Repubblica, Church of St. Mary of the Martyrs and the Angels, Piazza di Spagna (Spanish steps), Fontana di Trevi (Trevi Fountain), Piazza Rotunda, Piazza Navona, and Campo dei Fiori. Dinner is included.

23.10, Su Theme: From Sect to Imperial Church
Field trip: Catacombs of San Callisto, Vatican museums and Sistine chapel, Vatican City, St. Peter's Square, St. Peter's Basilica. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.
Overnight in Rome
- Day 9
24.10, M Theme: Underground Rome
Field trip: Ostia (ancient port of Rome), San Clemente Church, (Mithraeum), Domus Aurea/house of Nero (time permitting). Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.

- Day 10
25.10, Tu Theme: Monumental Architecture in Imperial Rome
Field trip: 9:45 AM The Coliseum, Imperial Forum, the Palatine, view the Circus Maximus, Baths of Caracalla,. Dinner is on your own in a restaurant close to the hotel.

- Day 11
26.10, W Return to the USA or continue on the elective to Sicily

Elective: 3 days Renaissance and Baroque Italy—Florence (\$1,228 based on a group of 10)

26.10, W Theme: Renaissance Italy
Field trip: depart Rome by train and arrive in Florence, walking tour including the central market
Dinner is on your own.

- Day 11
27.10, Th Theme: The Renaissance
Field trip: the Uffizi Gallery, the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, Galleria del Accademia. Dinner is on your own.
Overnight in Florence
- Day 12
28.10.F Theme: The Renaissance
Field trip: Free day for self directed exploration. Late afternoon train to Rome. Dinner is on your own.
Overnight in Rome
- Day 13
29.10, Sa return flight to the USA
